RADIO BROADCASTING STATION LICENSE

Subject to the provisions of the Radio Act of 1927, as amended on March 28, 1928, the regulations made thereunder and such subsequent acts and treaties, and regulations as may be established thereunder and the conditions mentioned in this license, all of which terms and conditions are hereby made a part hereof as though specifically set out in full herein,

HALE BROTHERS & THE CHRONICLE

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio apparatus herein described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term beginning 3 AM November 11, 1928, & ending 3 AM January 31, 1929, ~~except on Sundays~~ Eastern Standard Time unless this license is sooner suspended or revoked.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency or wave length specified herein, beyond the terms hereof, nor in any other manner nor at any other time or place than authorized herein. Neither the license nor right granted herein shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Radio Act of 1927, as amended, and this license is expressly subject in terms to the right of use or control conferred by Section 6 of said Radio Act.

The licensee is authorized to use and operate the apparatus located at Number 901

power output, 5000 (Watts); call letters, K P O;

time of operation, Unlimited

As one of the conditions of this license, the licensee is required during the term of this license to render adequate broadcasting service during the authorized time of operation, and a violation of this condition will be considered a ground for the suspension or revocation of this license.

The commission reserves the right at any time after the date of this license to make such changes in the frequency, power, and time of operation above authorized as will promote public interest or convenience, or will serve public necessity, or are necessary to comply with Section 9 of the Radio Act of 1927, as amended by Section 5 in the Act of Congress of March 28, 1928, or regulations made thereunder.
